

Plan 17

Description: This scenario assumes the Germans adopt an East first strategy. As the German 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 8th Armies storm into Poland, the French execute their Plan 17.

Start Turn: Same as TSP

End Turn: Same as TSP

Map Area: Entire Map

Entente Set-up:

Same as TSP. Mobilization same as TSP.

Reinforcement schedule:

Same as TSP.

Alliance Set-up:

German 5th Army

To the East of the 1914 Border between hexes 2306 and 2513

German 6th Army

To the East of the 1914 Border between hexes 2314 and 2718

German 7th Army

To the East of the 1914 Border between hexes 2818 and 2823

Reinforcement schedule:

Starting on the first turn in October the German player will receive 5 supply points each turn and 1 RPL XX each even number turn.

Scenario Specific Rules:

Belgium is still neutral. The first side to enter Belgium will lose 100 victory points and Belgium will ally with the other side.

Variable BEF use (Optional)

Roll one die on the first turn, after all units have setup, and apply the results.

Die Roll	Result
1	The BEF does not deploy to France
2	The BEF does not deploy unless German attacks Belgium
3	The BEF deploys but may not move unless German units capture a French city

4	The BEF deploys but may not move unless a German unit enters France
5	The BEF deploys but may not enter Germany
6	The BEF deploys and functions as per TSP rules

Victory Conditions:

After the last turn has been played, each player calculates the total of victory points achieved.

The French gain +5VPs for each unit east of the Rhine.

The French may achieve an Instant Victory by occupying the city centers of Ludwigshafen or Stuttgart.
